ADOPTION OF THE FINAL BUDGET
2018-2019

**Adjustment
Enrollment**

RESOLVED that the Stafford Township Board of Education does not include in the proposed budget an adjustment for enrollment. The adjustment amount is contributing to banked cap.

**Adjustment
Health Benefits**

RESOLVED that the Stafford Township Board of Education does not include in the proposed budget an adjustment for increased cost of health benefits. The adjustment amount is contributing to banked cap.

**Adjustment
PERS Pension**

RESOLVED that the Stafford Township Board of Education does not include in the proposed budget an adjustment for deferral of the PERS pension cost and the additional interest incurred. The adjustment amount is contributing to banked cap.

**Adjustment
Responsibility Transferred**

RESOLVED that the Stafford Township Board of Education does not include in the proposed budget an adjustment for increase (decrease) of costs associated with the transfer of responsibilities.

**Travel and Related Expense Reimbursement
2018-2019**

WHEREAS, the Stafford Township Board of Education recognizes school staff and Board members will incur travel expenses related to and within the scope of their current responsibilities and for travel that promotes the delivery of instruction or furthers the efficient operation of the school district; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 6A:23B-1.1 et seq. requires Board members to receive approval of these expenses by a majority of the full voting membership of the Board and staff members to receive prior approval of these expenses by the Superintendent of Schools and a majority of the full voting membership of the Board; and

WHEREAS, a Board of Education may establish, for regular district business travel only, an annual school year threshold of \$150 per staff member where prior Board approval shall not be required unless this annual threshold for a staff member is exceeded in a given school year (July 1 through June 30); and

WHEREAS, travel and related expenses not in compliance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23B-1.1 et seq, but deemed by the Board of Education to be necessary and unavoidable as noted on the approved Board of Education Out of District Travel and Reimbursement Forms; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Education approves all travel not in compliance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23B-1.1 et seq as being necessary and unavoidable as noted on the approved Board of Education Out of District Travel and Reimbursement Forms; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board of Education approves travel and related expense reimbursements in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23B-1.2(b), to a maximum expenditure of \$50,000 for all staff and board members.

BE IT RESOLVED that the final budget be approved for the 2018-2019 school year using the 2018-2019 state aid figures and the Secretary to the Board of Education be authorized to submit the following final budget to the Executive County Superintendent of Schools for approval in accordance with the statutory deadline:
