Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Stafford Township Board of Education will permit the use of bicycles and walking to and from school by pupils in grades three thru six only within a two-mile radius of pupil's home and school, in accordance with district policy 5514, provided such pupils present written parental approval, and have been granted permission by the building principal. Scooters, skateboards and other vehicles which do not meet the definition of bicycles are not permitted. If you would like your child to walk or ride their bicycle to school, please be aware of the following:

- There are no crossing guards at the main road into each school.
- If your child rides his/her bike, you will need to provide a lock for security.
- For safety, your child will be dismissed after all of the buses have exited the parking lot.
- Your child MUST wear a biker's helmet.
- The Board will not be responsible for any bicycle that is lost, stolen, or damaged.

Permission to walk or to ride a bicycle for travel to and from school is a privilege that can be revoked by the building principal if the student violates the rules set forth in the district's policy 5514.

If you would like to have your child be granted permission to walk or to ride his/her bicycle to and from school, please fill out the form below and return it to your child's school. The building principal will notify you if your request to walk/ride has been granted.
